



CUSHION CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

Mobelli's Acrylic cushions are made from the best materials and are easy to clean and maintain. Regular hosing down and wiping is all that is required to keep them looking great.

Stains and dirt are inevitable in the outdoor environment. To remove stains please leave the foam inside and wash the fabric with a mild soap solution. Never use a detergent. Rather mix water and dishwashing liquid to get a mild soap solution. Apply the solution and rub stains gently with a damp cloth. Rinse the cushions off with water to remove the residue from the cleaning solution. Leave the cushions in the sun to dry out completely.

If you prefer to machine wash the covers, please follow the following instructions carefully: To remove the cushion cover, unzip the zipper as far as it will go. Reach inside the cover and fold the left and right hand sides of the foam together. Once you have folded the foam in half, gently remove it from the fabric cover, manipulating the foam where necessary. Try not to pull on or stretch the cover too hard as this will cause tearing of the fabric and stitching.

Machine wash your cushion covers in COLD water. Do not tumble dry.

To re-stuff your cushion covers, once again open the zipper as wide as it will go. Fold the foam in half so you do not put pressure on the zip when inserting it into the cover. Place the foam inside the cover so that the front of the foam is right up against the front of the cover. And the back end of the cover (where the zip is) is pulled right over the back end of the foam. Do not let go of the folded foam until this point

Once the foam is completely inside its cover, you can release the sides. Reach inside the cover and gently maneuver the foam so that the sides of the foam are lined up with the sides of the cover and the corners are filled out. To neaten the finish of the cushion push all the seams down. Finally, to close the zipper push the foam inside the cushion as you zip it up a little at a time. Repeat until the zip is closed. For the best results iron the cushion once it has been stuffed. If your fabric is Teflon coated this will help to re-store the Teflon layer.
