Barca Queen Umbrella

Whilst the Barca Queen is a durable umbrella, it's not indestructible. It needs to be protected from high winds and needs to be maintained, especially if it's exposed to coastal conditions which will quickly cause it to rust if not maintained in the correct manner.

Please read these maintenance instructions carefully.

BARCA QUEEN BASE



This is a Barca Queen cross base which is starting to show signs of rust. Rust is inevitable; however, it should take years for it to surface. If the umbrella is exposed to the sea air, rust will settle in far quicker than usual. The sea air is extremely corrosive.

The base needs to be hosed down to remove the salt that has settled on the metal, this must be done regularly.

BARCA QUEEN SWIVEL MECHANISM



The swivel mechanism runs with ball bearings on the inside, which allows it to turn 360 degrees. If the ball bearings aren't lubricated regularly, the ball bearings will rust and fuse, which prevents the mechanism from swivelling.

Again, when near the sea, this will need to be carried out more than usual due to the corrosive elements. The lubricant can be



sprayed into the centre hole and then turn the swivel mechanism continuously to get the lubricant to work.

In order to swivel the umbrella, stand on the foot stopper in the picture and turn the umbrella whilst the foot stopper is down. In order to stop the umbrella from turning, release the foot stopper and the umbrella will lock into gear.



The winder is used to open and close the umbrella as well as tilt the umbrella from side to side. In the picture the winder is in the slot that opens the umbrella. The hole above that is the one that tilts the umbrella left or right.



The Main pole on the Barca Queen has holes on it where the handle will lock into place, giving you the desired height of the canopy. Merely hold the handle in and slide it up the Main pole until it locks in one of the holes.



Always ensure that your protective canopy is utilised when the umbrella isn't in use. The protective cover is there to do just that, protect the canopy of the umbrella from the elements and UV degradation.

What is not covered by the Guarantee:

- Damage caused by wind
- Damage caused by misuse
- Damage caused by negligence
- Damaged caused by wear and tear
- Damage caused in an environment with harsh conditions

PLEASE NOTE: Outdoor furniture does not mean indestructible furniture. Certain elements of nature may damage your furniture and invalidate your guarantee. Please protect your furniture specifically from the effects of wind. If you live in a windy area, know when the wind comes up and take precautions to ensure that the furniture does not get damaged. Please note that every product has a limited life span. The Southern African sun, in particular, is incredibly harsh and leads to faster deterioration of outdoor furniture than, say, in Europe. Treat your furniture kindly and your investment will last longer.
